

Budget-Friendly Itinerary



DAY 1 – WEST PALM BEACH

MORNING

- **Check-in:** Delta Hotels by Marriott, located just minutes away from the airport and from downtown West Palm Beach.
- **Breakfast:** Coffee and pastries at Salento Coffee, a Colombian coffee shop in downtown West Palm Beach.
- **Activity:** Exploring Clematis Street and the West Palm Beach Waterfront. On Saturday, visitors and locals can shop at several vendors at the West Palm Beach Green Market along Clematis Street.
- **Activity:** Historical Society of Palm Beach County, a nonprofit organization whose mission is to collect, preserve, and share the rich history and cultural heritage of Palm Beach County. They offer free admission. Donations are highly suggested.

AFTERNOON

- **Quick Lunch:** Affordable lunch at Howley’s Restaurant, a retro diner with classic American fare.
- **Activity:** Manatee Lagoon, a place dedicated to the conservation of this endangered animal through public education and discovery. Entrance is free.

EVENING

- **Dinner:** Havana Restaurant, a popular spot known for its Cuban cuisine.

DAY 2 – PALM BEACH

MORNING

- **Breakfast:** Oceanside breakfast at Dune Deck Café for fresh seafood and ocean views.
- **Activity:** Biking the Palm Beach Lake Trail: the perfect way to enjoy views of the Intracoastal Waterway and the West Palm Beach skyline.
- **Activity:** Society of the Four Art, a cultural campus with exhibits, a library, a sculpture garden, and more. Free entry.

AFTERNOON

- **Lunch:** Surfside Diner, a classic American Diner steps away from Worth Avenue and the ocean.
- **Activity:** Stroll on Worth Avenue and beach time in front of the iconic Clock Tower.

EVENING

- **Dinner:** Two Georges Waterfront Grille in Boynton Beach, a restaurant with tropical and waterfront views.

DAY 3 – OUTDOORS & ANIMAL ENCOUNTERS

MORNING

- **Brunch:** Benny’s on The Beach, a restaurant on the Lake Worth pier with beautiful ocean views.
- **Activity:** Beach time under the Lake Worth Pier.

AFTERNOON

- **Activity:** Cultural Council of Palm Beach County. The Cultural Council for Palm Beach County is the only organization solely dedicated to supporting arts and culture in The Palm Beaches, Florida’s Cultural Capital®. The main gallery showcases ongoing temporary exhibitions focused on art made in or unique to Palm Beach County. Admission is free.
- **Activity:** Exploring Downtown Lake Worth Beach and its quaint shops and boutiques.
- **Alternative free activities in Jupiter:** Busch Wildlife Sanctuary and Loggerhead Marine Life Center. Both offer free admission. Donations are recommended.

EVENING

- **Dinner:** La Casa del Mofongo, a popular restaurant serving the best Puerto Rican food for affordable prices.
