

Culinary Itinerary



DAY 1 – DELRAY BEACH

MORNING

- **Check in:** The Ray, a boutique luxury hotel in Delray Beach, just steps away from Atlantic Ave. This modern urban oasis offers a lush rooftop with a pool, bar, and two dining experiences on the property.
- **Activity:** Exploring downtown Delray Beach. Visitors can stroll along Atlantic Avenue and Pineapple Grove and shop local boutiques.

AFTERNOON

- **Lunch:** Le Colonial, a sultry French Indochine-inspired restaurant, right off Delray Beach’s Atlantic Avenue.
- **Activity:** The Silverball Museum, an interactive Museum with Pinball, Arcade, Original Coney Island Skee-ball, Shuffleboard, and more.
- **Snack:** Gelato time at Gelato & Co., an authentic Italian experience.
- **Activity:** Leisurely Stroll at the beach.

EVENING

- **Dinner:** Akira Back, a high-end restaurant located at The Ray hotel. There, Michelin star chef Akira Back serves a blend of modern Japanese cuisine with authentic Korean flavors.
- **Activity:** Cocktail time at Rosewater Rooftop, the terrace of The Ray Hotel.

DAY 2 – WEST PALM BEACH

MORNING

- **Breakfast:** Lulu’s Café & Cocktails, a neighborhood café & bar in Delray Beach. Alternatively, stop by Aioli Bakery & Café on your way up to West Palm Beach.

AFTERNOON

- **Activity/Brunch:** West Palm Beach Food Tour, a complete food tour of West Palm Beach to discover the city’s culinary scene, local eateries, and hidden gems.
- **Activity:** Norton Museum of Art. The museum is home to a diverse collection of American, European, and contemporary art, and a beautiful sculpture garden.
- **Activity:** Shopping at CityPlace, a buzzing outdoor shopping area with boutiques and restaurants.

EVENING

- **Dinner:** Moody Tongue Sushi at Hilton West Palm Beach, an exclusive omakase experience.
- **Activity:** Night out at the Treehouse, a beautiful rooftop downtown with a bar and live music.

DAY 3 – BOCA RATON

MORNING

- **Activity:** The Schmidt Boca Raton History Museum, which collects preserves, and presents information and artifacts relevant to the past and evolving history of Boca Raton.
- **Activity:** Leisure time at The Ray pool.

EVENING

- **Dinner:** Amar Mediterranean Bistro, an intimate Mediterranean restaurant off Atlantic Ave.
- **Activity:** Throw Social, a tropical venue in downtown Delray Beach with live music, games, and cocktails.
